

# National Population Health Survey, 2010/2011

Released at 8:30 a.m. Eastern time in *The Daily*, Wednesday, September 12, 2012

The final cycle of the National Population Health Survey, covering the 2010/2011 period is now available. With this last release researchers will have access to nine cycles of Canadian longitudinal health data to examine the dynamics of population health from 1994/1995 to 2010/2011.
