

# Dairy statistics, February 2015

Released at 8:30 a.m. Eastern time in *The Daily*, Wednesday, April 22, 2015

---

Consumers purchased 225 232 kilolitres of milk and cream in February, down 4.5% from February 2014.

Sales of milk decreased 4.6% from the same month a year earlier to 199 605 kilolitres in February, while cream sales decreased 3.6% to 25 627 kilolitres.
