## Poultry and egg statistics, July 2015

Released at 8:30 a.m. Eastern time in The Daily, Monday, September 28, 2015

Egg production increased 4.8% in July from the same month a year earlier to 58.3 million dozen.

Placements of hatchery chicks on farms decreased 1.2% to 58.9 million birds in August compared with the same month a year earlier.

Stocks of frozen poultry meat in cold storage on September 1 were up 10.2% from the same date a year earlier to 84 307 tonnes.

## Note to readers

Poultry and egg statistics are available for Canada and the provinces.

Data on egg production are available for July. Data on the placements of hatchery chicks and turkey poults are available for August. Data on stocks of frozen eggs and poultry meats as well as edible dried egg products are available for September.
