

# Production and disposition of tobacco products, March 2016

Released at 8:30 a.m. Eastern time in *The Daily*, Tuesday, April 26, 2016

Canadian manufacturers produced 1.9 billion cigarettes in March, up 20.8% from February. Cigarette production increased 1.1% from the same month a year earlier.

The total number of cigarettes sold in March increased 21.3% from February to 1.8 billion and was up 7.6% from March 2015.
