Aircraft movement statistics: Major airports, February 2016

Released at 8:30 a.m. Eastern time in The Daily, Thursday, April 28, 2016

There were 375,650 aircraft take-offs and landings at the 91 Canadian airports with NAV CANADA air traffic control towers and flight service stations in February, compared with 356,119 movements in February 2015.

The growth in aircraft movements in February was partly attributable to the extra day for the leap year.

Both itinerant movements (flights from one airport to another) and local movements (flights that remain in the vicinity of the airport) increased in February. Itinerant movements were up 3.8% to 270,946, while local movements rose 10.0% to 104,704.
