Provincial and territorial economic accounts: Government revenue, expenditure and budgetary balance, 2014

Detailed government revenues, expenditures and budgetary balance by province and territory, for the years 2007 to 2014, are now available.

These estimates are an extension of the provincial and territorial economic accounts, released in November 2015. They are presented in CANSIM table 384-0047 in a structure similar to the budgetary balance tables in the national income and expenditure accounts (CANSIM 380-0080), with detailed revenues, detailed expenditures, surplus/deficit and net lending for each government subsector and for each province and territory.
