Poultry and egg statistics, December 2016

Released at 8:30 a.m. Eastern time in The Daily, Tuesday, February 28, 2017

Egg production rose 6.0% from December 2015 to 64.3 million dozen in December 2016.

In January, placements of hatchery chicks on farms increased 1.5% compared with the same month a year earlier to 62.1 million birds.

Stocks of frozen poultry meat in cold storage on February 1, 2017, increased 3.9% from the same date a year earlier to 74 275 tonnes.

Data on egg production are available for December. Data on the placements of hatchery chicks and turkey poults are available for January. Data on stocks of frozen eggs and poultry meats as well as edible dried egg products are available for February.
