Data from the National Fire Information Database for 2005 to 2014 are now available.

Note to readers

The data summarized in the CANSIM tables are drawn from the [National Fire Information Database \(NFID\)](#), which was conducted as a pilot project led by the Canadian Association of Fire Chiefs in collaboration with the Fire Marshalls and Fire Commissioners through a grant from the federal government. The pilot database includes data from seven jurisdictions: New Brunswick, Ontario, Manitoba, Saskatchewan, Alberta, British Columbia and the Canadian Armed Forces.
