

Aircraft movement statistics: Small airports, December 2017

Released at 8:30 a.m. Eastern time in *The Daily*, Thursday, April 12, 2018

Take-offs and landings at 126 Canadian airports without air traffic control towers reached a total of 36,335 movements in December.

Ten airports accounted for 44% of the month's activity: Peterborough, Ontario (2,629 movements); Moosonee, Ontario (2,379); Red Lake, Ontario (2,036); Goose Bay, Newfoundland and Labrador (1,899); Pickle Lake, Ontario (1,386); Island Lake, Manitoba (1,282); St. Theresa Point, Manitoba (1,251); Trois-Rivières, Quebec (1,140); Comox, British Columbia (1,056); and Drummondville, Quebec (771).

Note to readers

The December 2017 edition is the last issue of the service bulletin Monthly Aircraft Movements: Small airports – Airports without NAVCANADA Towers or Flight Service Stations. Monthly data will continue to be made available in The Daily and on CANSIM tables 401-0021 and 401-0022.

This survey collects data on itinerant and local aircraft movements at airports without a NAVCANADA Air Traffic Control Tower or a NAVCANADA Flight Service Station.

*An **aircraft movement** is defined as a take-off, a landing, or a simulated approach by an aircraft.*

Data for the same month in the previous year may have been revised.

Annual estimates are released each year.

The data in this monthly release are not seasonally adjusted.
