

Couriers and Messengers Services Price Index, July 2018

Released at 8:30 a.m. Eastern time in *The Daily*, Friday, August 31, 2018

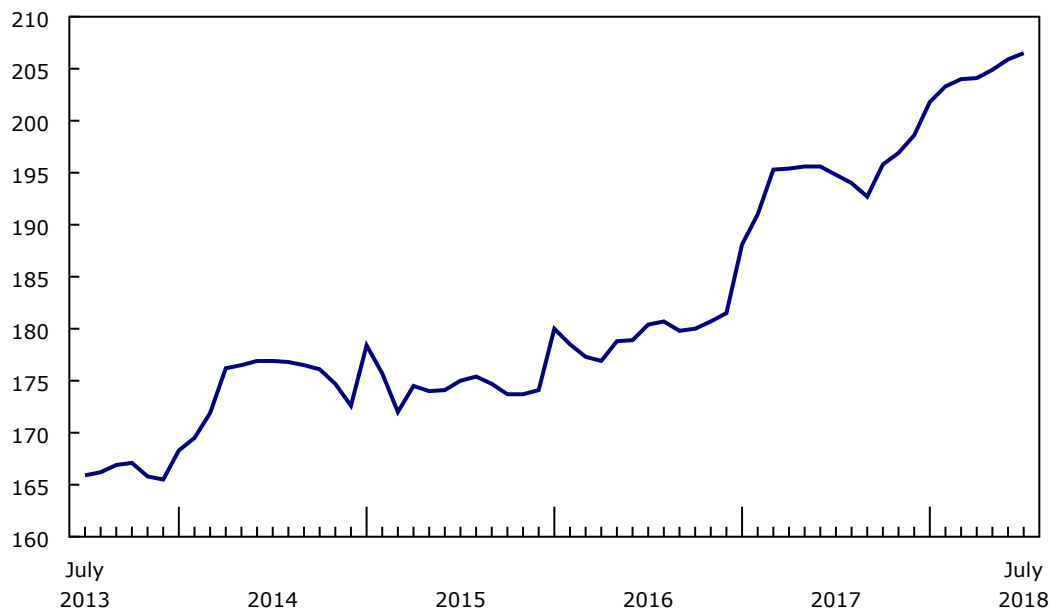
The Couriers and Messengers Services Price Index (CMSPI) rose 0.3% in July, following a 0.5% increase in June. The couriers component was up 0.4% while the local messengers and local delivery component posted no change.

Year-over-year change

The CMSPI rose 6.0% in July compared with the same month last year. Both the couriers (+5.9%) and the local delivery (+6.6%) components increased.

Note to readers

The *Couriers and Messengers Services Price Index* is a monthly index that measures the price changes for courier and messenger services provided by long- and short-distance delivery companies to Canadian-based business clients.

Data are available at the Canada level only.

With each release, data for the previous six months may have been revised. The index is not seasonally adjusted.
