

Number and Salaries of Full-time Teaching Staff at Canadian Universities (partial), 2011/2012 to 2015/2016

Released at 8:30 a.m. Eastern time in The Daily, Monday, September 24, 2018

The University and College Academic Staff System (UCASS) provides Canadians with a detailed portrait of full-time academic staff in Canadian universities, including gender, age, principal subject taught, academic rank, salary and administrative stipends and province or country of degrees earned. It is based on administrative data provided to Statistics Canada by participating Canadian universities.

This is a release of partial data on full-time academic teaching staff for the period 2011/2012 to 2015/2016. It includes those universities that participated in the data collection initiative conducted by Western University during the period of cancellation of the pan-Canadian data collection (2012 to 2016) and who authorized the release of these data to Statistics Canada by the end of August 2018.

A complete file which includes all participating universities for the years 2011/2012 to 2015/2016 will be released once the other institutions that participated in the data collection initiative conducted by Western University have finalized and authorized their data. This file will also include aggregated provincial estimates for those institutions that did not provide data for this period.
