Salary and salary scales of full-time teaching staff at Canadian universities, 2011/2012 to 2015/2016 (final)

Final data are now available on full-time university academic teaching staff in public universities for the years 2011/2012 to 2015/2016 from the Full-time University and College Academic Staff System (FT-UCASS). A partial file of these data was released on September 24, 2018.

This release is closing the data gap left by the cancellation of the survey in 2012 by Statistics Canada in order to meet its saving targets. The survey was re-instated in September 2016. During the period of the survey cancellation (2011/2012 to 2015/2016), UCASS data were collected independently by participating universities in association with the National Vice-President's Academic Council. This information plus estimates for those institutions that did not participate in the independent data collection are included in this release.

In addition, the UCASS database (1970/1971 to 2017/2018) has been updated to include the 2016 Classification of Instructional Program and updated country codes.
