

# Study: Educational and labour market outcomes of children with an immigrant background by their region of origin, 2006 and 2016

The study "[Educational and labour market outcomes of children with an immigrant background by their region of origin](#)" is now available as part of the *Ethnicity, Languages and Immigration Thematic Series* ([89-657-X](#)).

Based on integrated data from the 2006 and 2016 censuses, the study examines the education and labour market outcomes of a cohort of children with an immigrant background.

It compares the outcomes of children of immigrants from various regions of origin with those of children with Canadian-born parents.
