A new edition of the publication *Health Indicators* ([82-221-X](#)) is now available. The following health region level estimates from the Canadian Institute for Health Information have been updated: 30-Day Obstetric Readmission, 30-Day Pediatric Readmission, 30-Day Surgical Readmission, 30-Day Medical Readmission, and Hip Fracture Surgery Within 48 Hours.

The *Health Indicators* publication includes over 80 indicators that measure the health of the Canadian population and the effectiveness of the health care system. Designed to provide comparable information at the health region and provincial/territorial levels, these data are produced from a wide range of the most recently available sources.

Note to readers

Health regions are defined by the provinces and territories, and represent administrative areas or regions of interest to health authorities.
