

Personal Protective Equipment Survey, August 2020

Released at 8:30 a.m. Eastern time in *The Daily*, Friday, October 9, 2020

Data from the Personal Protective Equipment Survey are now available for August. This survey provides estimates of personal protective equipment (PPE) demand and supply, by type of PPE. Data are available at the Canada and regional levels and are grouped by industry.
