

Government finance statistics, third quarter 2021

Released at 8:30 a.m. Eastern time in *The Daily*, Tuesday, January 11, 2022

Quarterly financial data for the Canadian general government and its subsectors from the first quarter of 1990 to the third quarter of 2021 are now available. These subsectors include the federal government, provincial-territorial governments, local governments, and the Canada and Quebec Pension Plans.

Government Finance Statistics presents fiscal statistics using the International Monetary Fund standard. This standard allows consistent aggregation and analysis between participating countries.

Note to readers

Currently, *Government Finance Statistics (GFS)* quarterly data are derived by mapping Canada's System of National Accounts data to GFS concepts and conventions.

This release of GFS includes revised data for the first quarter of 1990 to the second quarter of 2021.
