

Quarterly capital spending: Oil and gas industries, first quarter 2022

Released at 8:30 a.m. Eastern time in *The Daily*, Wednesday, June 1, 2022

Capital expenditures in the oil and gas extraction industries rose 7.0% to \$7.7 billion in the first quarter.

Note to readers

Capital expenditures are the gross expenditures on fixed assets, including exploration and evaluation, for use in the operations of an organization or for lease or rent to others.

Revised capital expenditure data for the oil and gas extraction industries will be published on September 1, 2022.

Data in this release are seasonally adjusted and are expressed in current dollars, unless otherwise specified.
