

Electric Power Selling Price Index, April 2022

Released at 8:30 a.m. Eastern time in *The Daily*, Wednesday, June 8, 2022

The Electric Power Selling Price Index (2014=100) is now available for April 2022.

Note to readers

The Electric Power Selling Price Index is a monthly series that measures the price variations in sales of electricity by distributors to commercial and industrial users. Data are available for Canada, by region and by province.

With each release, data for the previous 12 months may have been revised. The index is not seasonally adjusted.
