

Question-level quality indicators for the 2021 Census of Population

Data quality indicators for questions asked on the 2021 Census of Population questionnaires are now available. These quality indicators include [non-response rates](#) and [imputation rates](#) for most of the questions asked of the total population. Quality indicators are also available for key income variables.

Data tables containing question-level quality indicators for the 2021 Census of Population are produced for many geographic levels. These quality-indicator-specific tables can be used in conjunction with the topic-based data tables to assess the quality of statistics produced.
