
## Canadian international trade in services, **March 2023**

Released at 8:30 a.m. Eastern time in The Daily, Thursday, May 4, 2023

Canada's monthly international trade in services deficit was essentially unchanged in March, at \$2.0 billion. Overall, exports of services were up 0.2% to \$14.0 billion, as an increase in commercial services (+0.6%) was moderated by a decline in travel services (-1.0%). Imports edged up 0.1% to \$16.0 billion, reflecting higher commercial services (+1.0%), which was partially offset by lower transportation services (-2.8%).

Chart 1 International trade in services



In March, total imports of goods decreased 2.9% from February to \$62.6 billion, and total exports of goods were down 0.7% to \$63.6 billion, resulting in a surplus of \$1.0 billion. Combined, the trade balance for goods and services amounted to a deficit of \$1.0 billion in March, compared with a deficit of \$2.5 billion in February.




