## Canadian international trade in services, July 2023



Canada's monthly international trade in services deficit widened from \$1.1 billion in June to \$1.4 billion in July. Overall, imports of services were up 1.7% to \$16.4 billion, while exports of services edged down 0.3% to \$15.0 billion.

The increase in imports was led by higher payments of travel services (+13.6%) predominately made by Canadian travellers returning from the United States. This increase was partially offset by lower imports of transportation services (-9.9%), as the British Columbia marine port strike and its effects on the imports of goods reduced payments for marine transportation services. The decrease in exports was mainly due to lower exports of commercial services (-0.4%), mainly in the form of financial services.

Total imports of goods decreased 5.4% from June to \$61.4 billion in July, and total exports of goods were up 0.7% to \$60.4 billion, resulting in a deficit of \$1.0 billion in July. Combined, the trade balance for goods and services amounted to a deficit of \$2.4 billion in July compared with a deficit of \$6.0 billion in June.





The services trade deficit in June, originally reported at \$1.0 billion in the previous release, was revised up to \$1.1 billion with this month's release, as imports (+\$454 million) and exports (+\$360 million) were revised up. The revisions reflected with this month's release are primarily due to the integration of quarterly benchmark data from the balance of payments for the second quarter, as well as revisions to the data for the first quarter.

**Chart 2 International trade in services, balances** 




