

# Sawmills, March 2025

Released at 8:30 a.m. Eastern time in *The Daily*, Tuesday, June 3, 2025

Lumber production increased 17.3% from February to 4 325.9 thousand cubic metres in March. Production was down 1.6% from March 2024.

Sawmills shipped 4 200.6 thousand cubic metres of lumber in March, up 22.5% from February and down 2.9% from March 2024.
