

Sawmills, April 2025

Released at 8:30 a.m. Eastern time in *The Daily*, Friday, July 4, 2025

Lumber production decreased 1.1% from March to 4 278.2 thousand cubic metres in April. Production was down 6.1% from April 2024.

Sawmills shipped 3 955.5 thousand cubic metres of lumber in April, down 5.8% from March and down 6.0% from April 2024.
