

Value added in exports, 2024

Released at 8:30 a.m. Eastern time in *The Daily*, Monday, May 4, 2026

National data on the value added in exports for 2024 are now available. The national data on the value added in exports for 2022 and 2023 have been revised.

The provincial data on the value added in exports for 2022 are now available.

Note to readers

The value added in exports database provides data on the exports and imports of industries, as well as on the direct and indirect impact of exports on gross domestic product and jobs by industry. Industry impacts can be viewed from the perspective of their impact on other industries or from the perspective of an industry's dependence on other industries. Data cover the period from 2007 to 2024 and rely on the supply and use tables, which provide the basis for the calculations.

The estimates for 2023 and 2024 are only available nationally. They are based on advanced estimates of the Canadian supply and use tables that were modelled based on industry indicators of output and gross value added and benchmarked to published income and expenditure account figures.

The article entitled "[Value added and job creation associated with Canadian manufacturing exports to the United States: An update from the 2024 value added in exports data](#)" highlights the 2024 value added in exports data for Canadian manufacturing and provides detailed estimates for manufacturing industries that have been directly impacted by the onset, in March 2025, of significant tariffs on Canadian exports to the United States.
