

Quarterly capital spending: Oil and gas industries, first quarter 2026

Released at 8:30 a.m. Eastern time in *The Daily*, Monday, June 1, 2026

Capital expenditures in the oil and gas extraction industries totalled \$10.2 billion in the first quarter of 2026, down 12.6% from the previous quarter.

Note to readers

Capital expenditures are the gross expenditures on fixed assets, including exploration and evaluation, for use in the operations of an organization or for lease or rent to others.

Data in this release are seasonally adjusted and are expressed in current dollars, unless otherwise specified.
