Production and disposition of tobacco products, March 2016

Released at 8:30 a.m. Eastern time in The Daily, Tuesday, April 26, 2016

Canadian manufacturers produced 1.9 billion cigarettes in March, up 20.8% from February. Cigarette production increased 1.1% from the same month a year earlier.

The total number of cigarettes sold in March increased 21.3% from February to 1.8 billion and was up 7.6% from March 2015.

These data are subject to revision and are not seasonally adjusted.

The monthly survey, Production and Disposition of Tobacco Products, measures the quantities of tobacco products that are produced and sold by Canadian manufacturers.
