

Sawmills, June 2018

Released at 8:30 a.m. Eastern time in *The Daily*, Thursday, August 30, 2018

Lumber production fell 7.1% from May to 5 555.4 thousand cubic metres of lumber in June. Production was 2.9% lower than in June 2017.

Sawmills shipped 5 728.0 thousand cubic metres of lumber in June, down 8.4% from May and 0.5% lower compared with June 2017.
