

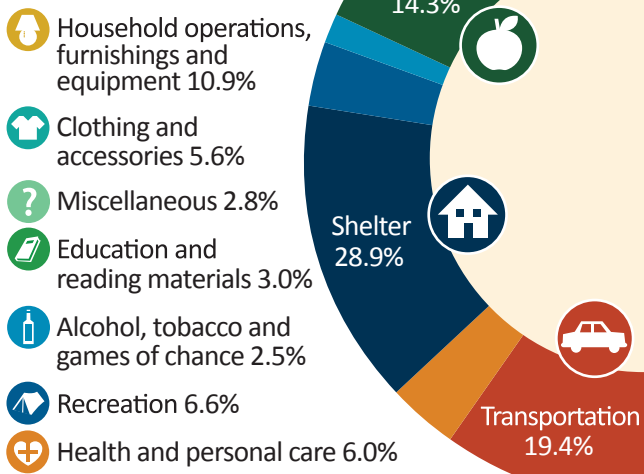

How Canadians spent their money in 2015

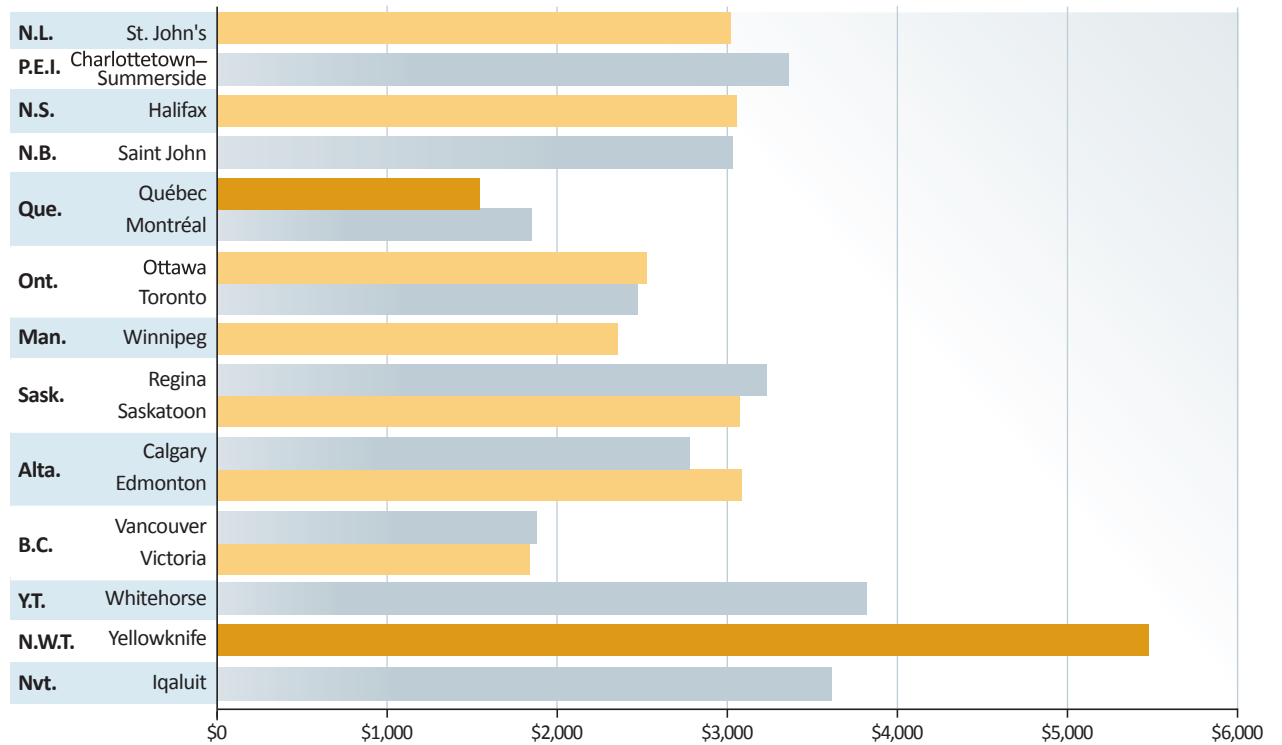

Average annual expenditure on goods and services per household.



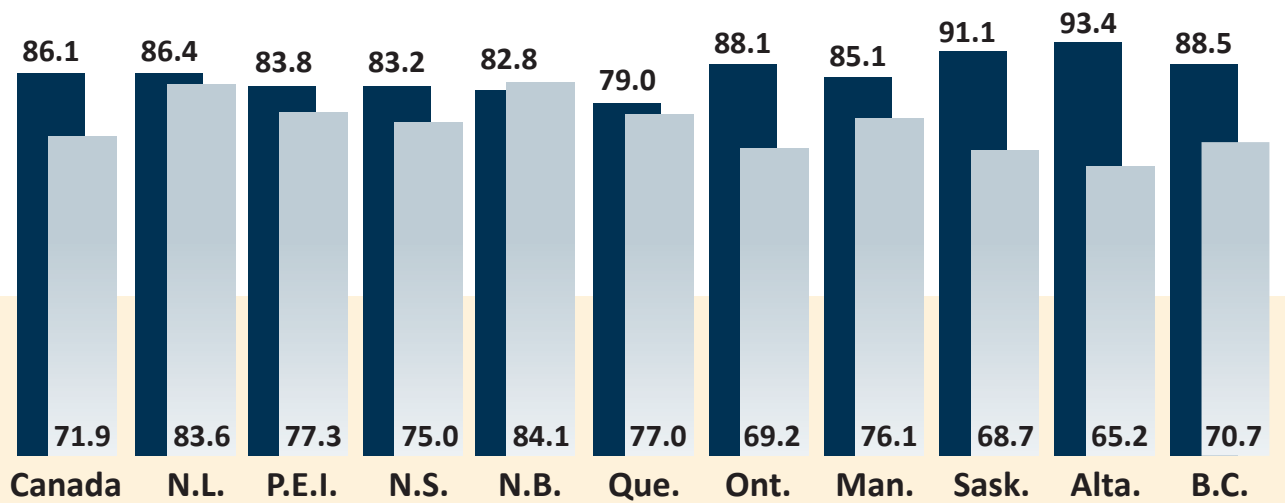
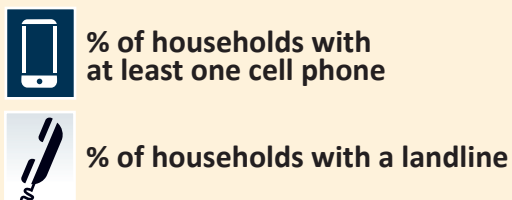
Water, fuel and electricity for principal accommodation
