

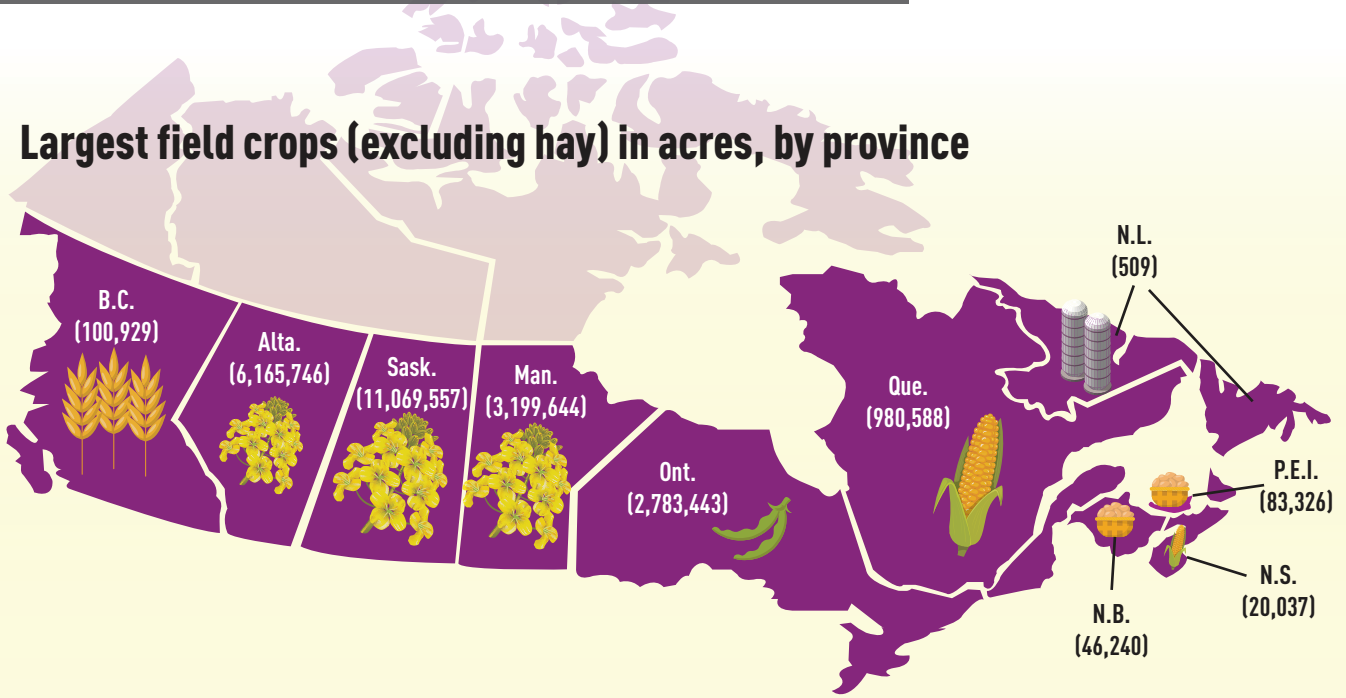
Field Crops in Canada



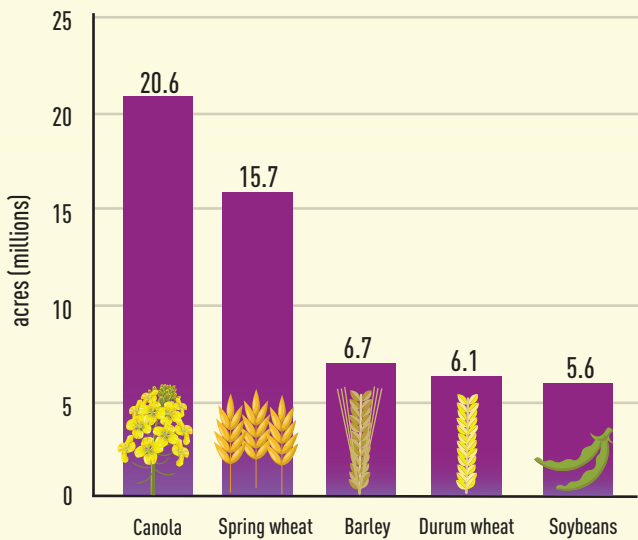
In 2016, field crops and hay covered **92.7 million acres**. Over the last 50 years the average acreage of field crops and hay has tripled to **479 acres per farm operation**.

Largest field crops by acreage in 2016

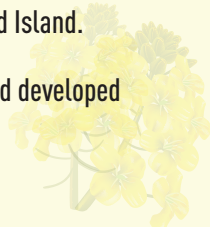


Crops on the rise

- 3x** Lentil acreage has more than tripled over the last 15 years to 5.6 million acres.
- 2x** Soybean acreage has doubled over the last 15 years to 5.6 million acres.

Did you know?

- 1 in 4 acres of potatoes in Canada were in Prince Edward Island.
- In 2016, 1 in 6 farms reported growing canola, an oilseed developed in Canada.
