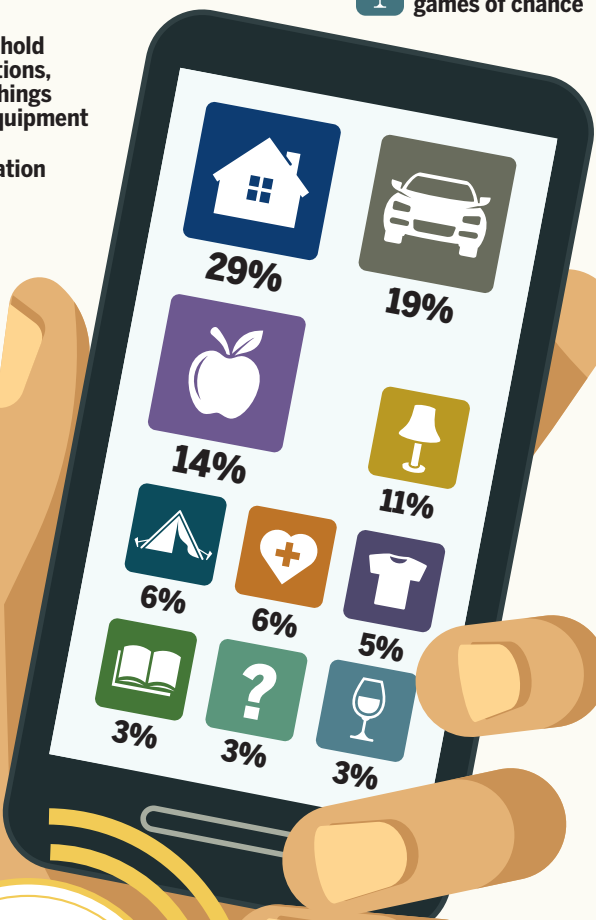


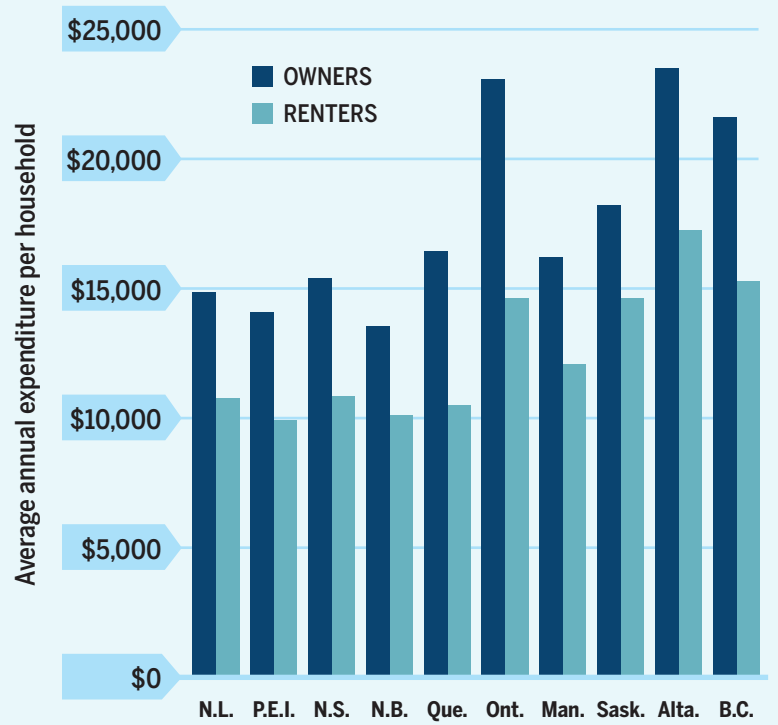

SHELTER COSTS FOR OWNERS AND RENTERS ACROSS CANADA



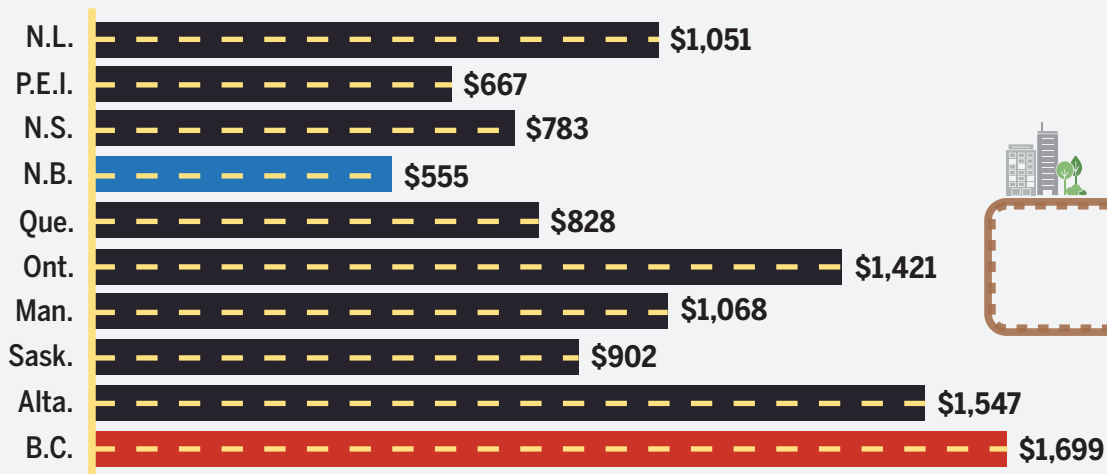
IN 2016, CANADIAN HOUSEHOLDS SPENT ON AVERAGE \$8,784 ON FOOD
