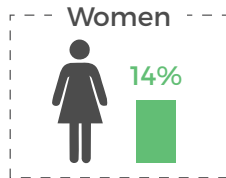


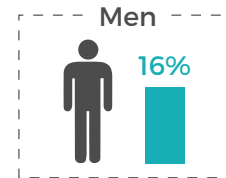
UNDER THE SAME ROOF

Living With My Parents!

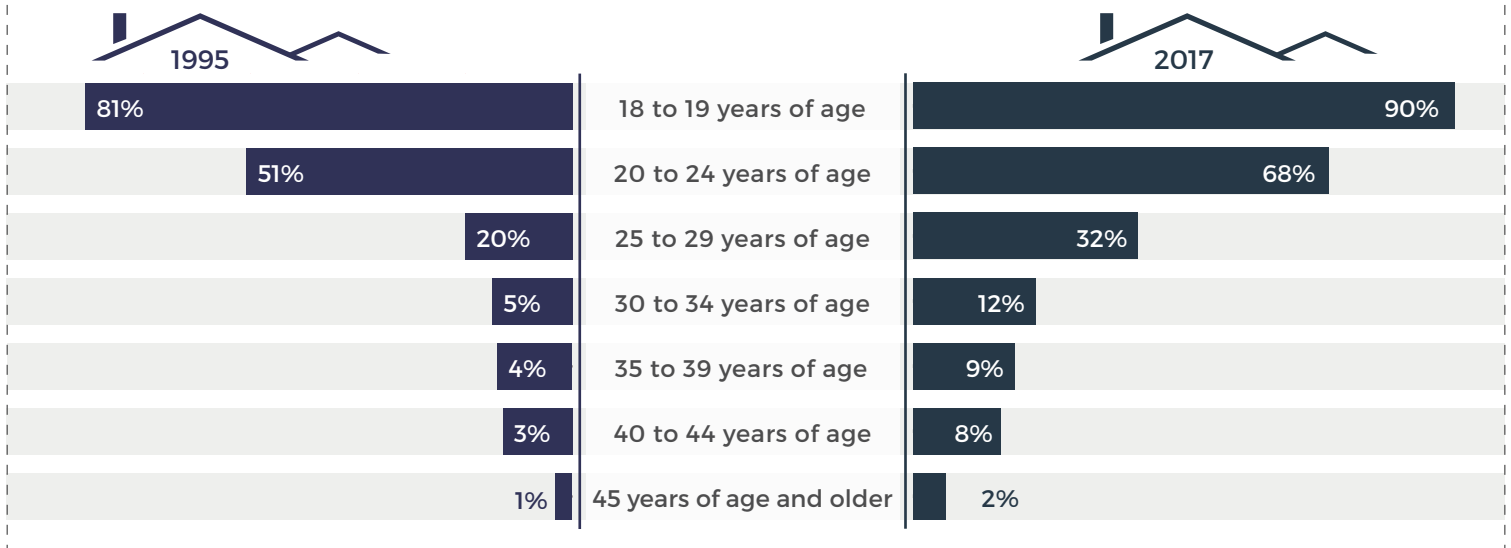
In 2017, 4.5 million people or 15% of Canadians aged 18 and over were living with a parent.ⁱ



In general, men were slightly more likely than women to live with a parent.



Over the past 20 years, the proportion of adults who live with a parent has increased.



Among adults who live with a parent

85%
had never left the parental home



70%
were employedⁱⁱ



10%
had a least one child who also lived with them
