CANADA'S OFFICIAL POVERTY LINE IS CALCULATED USING THE **MARKET BASKET MEASURE**, WHICH REFLECTS THE COMBINED COSTS OF A BASKET OF GOODS AND SERVICES THAT INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES REQUIRE TO MEET THEIR BASIC NEEDS AND ACHIEVE A MODEST STANDARD OF LIVING.

CANADIANS LIVING BELOW CANADA'S OFFICIAL POVERTY LINE IN 2018
