ABSTRACT

Some of the most commonly used statistical models are fit using maximum likelihood (ML), or some extension of ML. Stata's `-ml-` command provides researchers and data analysts with a tool to develop estimation commands to fit their models using their data. Such models may include multiple equations, clustered observations, sampling weights, and other survey design characteristics.
