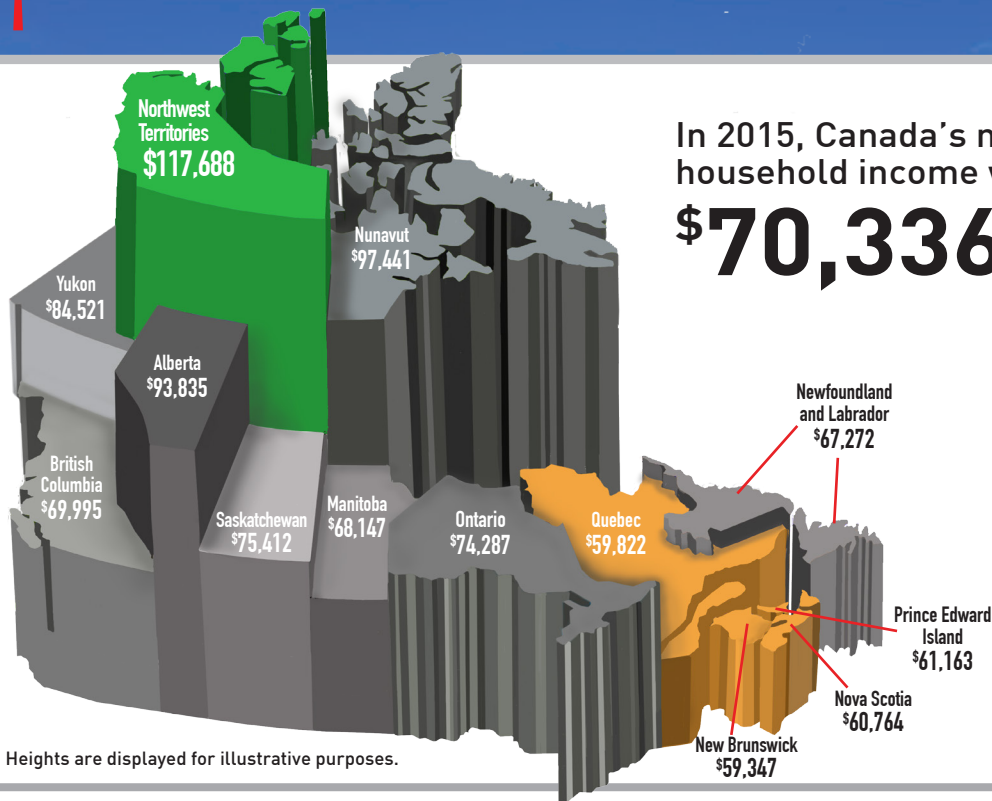

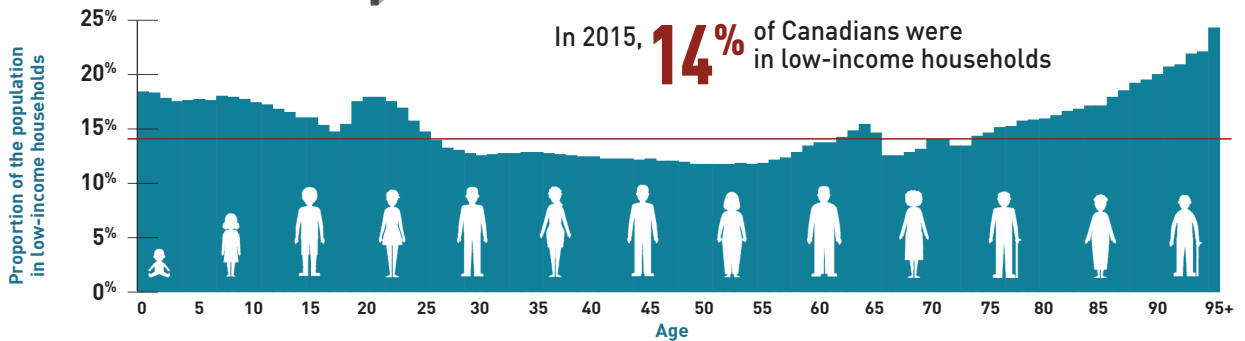


In 2015, Canada's median household income was **\$70,336**

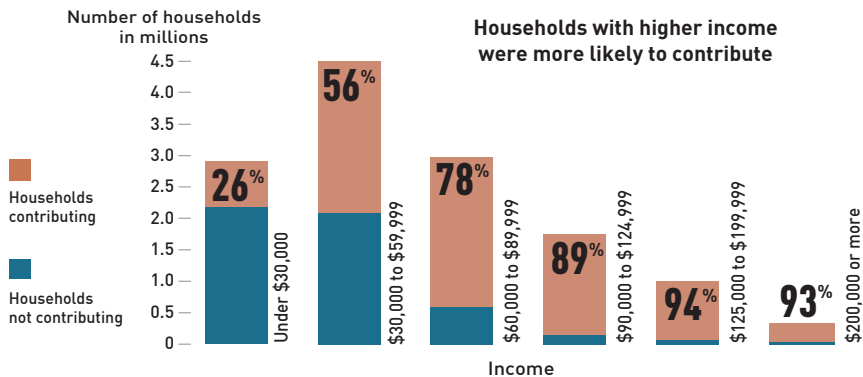
The **Northwest Territories** had the highest median household income, while the **Maritime Provinces** and **Quebec** had the lowest

Children, young adults, pre-retirees and older seniors were more likely to be in low-income households

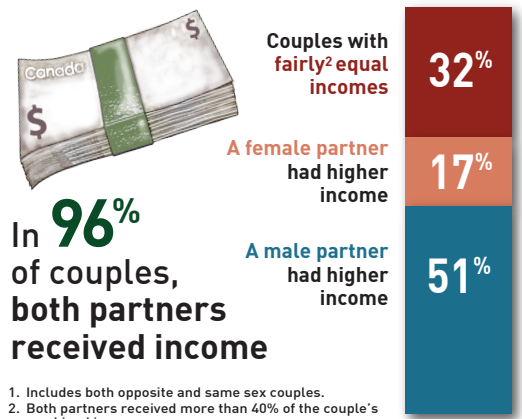


65% of households contributed to an RRSP, RPP or TFSA*
