

ZERO-EMISSION VEHICLES IN BRITISH COLUMBIA

FIRST HALF OF 2020



In the first and second quarters of 2020,

8.4%

of new vehicle registrations in British Columbia were zero-emission vehicles (ZEVs).

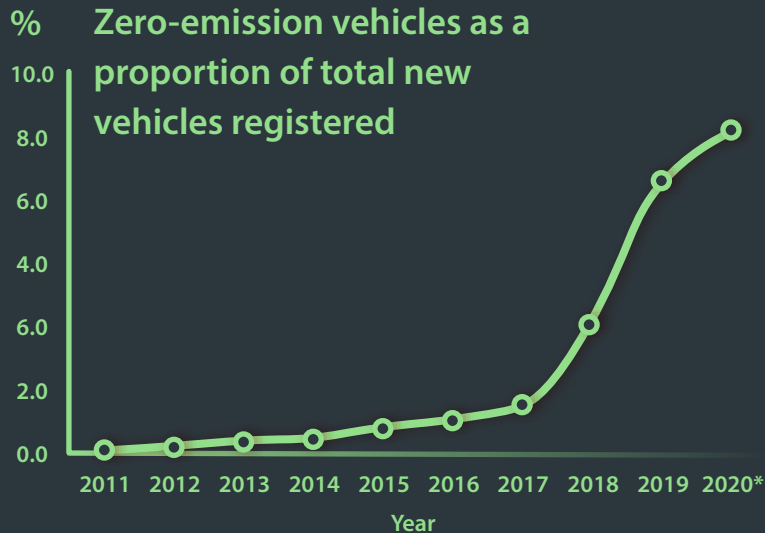
78.5%

of these ZEVs were battery electric vehicles.

In this period,

6,515

new ZEVs were registered in British Columbia.

13.4%

of total new vehicles registered.

11.0%

of new vehicles registered were ZEVs.
