The System of National Accounts

In Canada, the National Accounts have been developed since the close of the Second World War in a series of publications relating to their constituent parts. These have now reached a stage of evolution where they can be termed a "System of National Accounts". For purposes of identification, all publications (containing tables of statistics, descriptions of conceptual frameworks and descriptions of sources and methods) which make up this System carry the term "System of National Accounts" as a general title.

The System of National Accounts in Canada consists of several parts. The annual and quarterly Income and Expenditure Accounts (included with Catalogue Nos. carrying the prefix 13) were, historically speaking, the first set of statistics to be referred to with the title "National Accounts" (National Accounts, Income and Expenditure). The Balance of International Payments data (Catalogue Nos. with prefix 67) are also part of the System of National Accounts and they, in fact, pre-date the Income and Expenditure Accounts.

Greatly expanded structural detail on industries and on goods and services is portrayed in the Input-Output Tables of the System (Catalogue Nos. with prefix 15). The Catalogue Nos. carrying the prefix 15 also provide measures of the contribution of each industry to total Gross Domestic Product at basic prices as well as Productivity Measures.

Both the Input-Output tables and the estimates of Gross Domestic Product by Industry use the establishment as the primary unit of industrial production. Measures of financial transactions are provided by the Financial Flow Accounts (Catalogue Nos. with prefix 13). Types of lenders and financial instruments are the primary detail in these statistics and the legal entity is the main unit of classification of transactors. Balance sheets of outstanding assets and liabilities are published annually.

The System of National Accounts provides an overall conceptually integrated framework in which the various parts can be considered as interrelated sub-systems. At present, direct comparisons amongst those parts which use the establishment as the basic unit and those which use the legal entity can be carried out only at highly aggregated levels of data. However, Statistics Canada is continuing research on enterprise company establishment relationships; it may eventually be feasible to reclassify the data which are on one basis (say the establishment basis) to correspond to the units employed on another (the company or the enterprise basis).

In its broad outline, the Canadian System of National Accounts bears a close relationship to the international standard as described in System of National Accounts, 1993, a joint publication of the Commission of the European Communities, International Monetary Fund, Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development, United Nations and World Bank.

Foreword

About the figures

The series on international security transactions cover portfolio transactions in stocks, bonds and money market securities between non-residents and residents of Canada. The series include trade in outstanding issues, new issues, retirements, and change in interest payable and are further segmented by issuing sector and major geographic area. The principle guiding their construction is that a change of ownership occurs between residents of a foreign country and Canada. These series form an integral part of Canada's balance of payments. Certain types of security transactions, which are excluded from this publication, are classified to other balance of payments series as follows:

- security transactions representing direct investment capital by principal owners of an enterprise, e.g. parent companies subscribing to new stocks;
- foreign securities held as part of Canada's official international reserves or by Canadian banks for their own account;

Security transactions are recorded before charges for fees and commissions. The value used is the transaction price and the timing of a transaction's recording is generally the delivery or settlement date.

The quality of foreign portfolio investment data in Canadian stocks, bonds and money market paper is good. The flows are reported on a monthly survey sent to the major investment dealers, pension funds, and the largest debt issuing institutions such as the provinces and their enterprises. Historically, the response rate has been well over 90%. A considerable effort is made to identify the various sectors and institutions which issue securities to non-residents; the data may, at times, be revised when new transactors are identified or information becomes available through annual surveys. The coverage is validated against administrative data and the annual census survey of foreign holdings of Canadian portfolio investments.

The quality of estimates of Canadian investment in foreign stocks, bonds, and money market paper is not as good as it is difficult to identify all Canadian residents making portfolio investments abroad. A considerable effort is made to identify the various Canadian institutions which invest in foreign securities and survey them on a monthly basis however individuals in the personal sector using foreign investment firms are harder to identify thereby weakening the estimates. The quality of the data has improved significantly with a series of annual surveys on Canadian portfolio investment abroad that began at year-end 1997. The inaugural survey was carried out as part of an international effort to improve data on external portfolio investment. Fully 35 countries participated in the portfolio survey, co-ordinated by the International Monetary Fund.

For transactions in outstanding securities, the data are largely derived from a monthly survey of investment dealers and of other financial institutions such as mutual funds, pension funds and trust companies which regularly buy or sell securities directly through dealers or brokers outside Canada. The data for new issues and retirements are obtained from survey and non-survey sources such as prospectuses, summaries prepared by dealers and other institutions, press reports, etc.

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Highlights

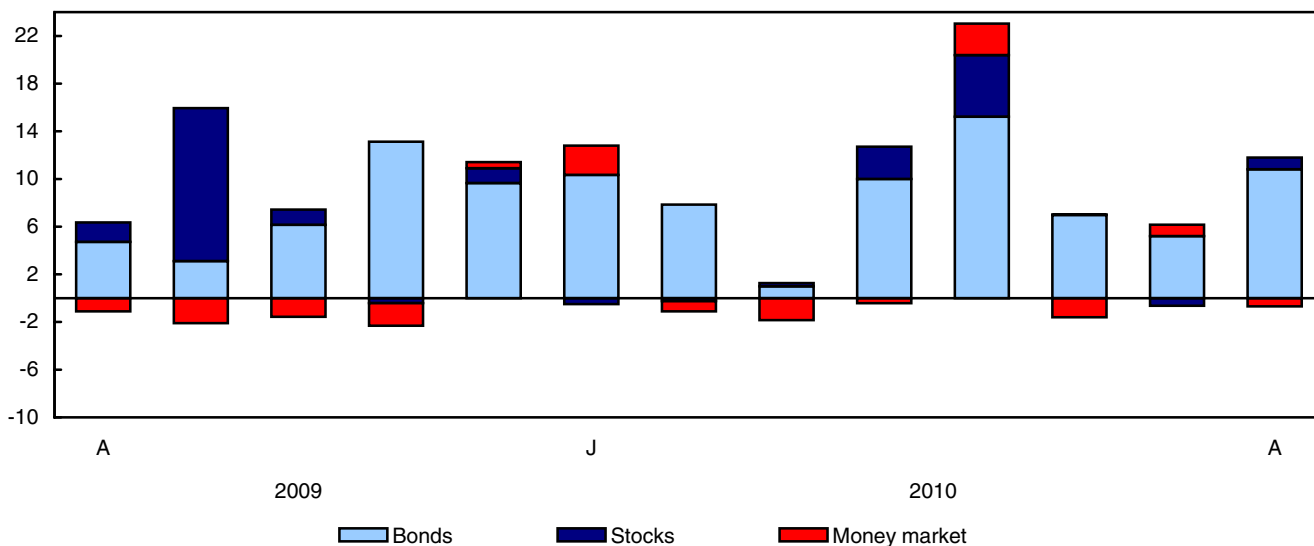
Non-residents purchased \$11.1 billion of Canadian securities in August with the majority of the investment going to corporate and government business enterprise bonds. Meanwhile, Canadians acquired \$3.4 billion of foreign securities, led by foreign stocks.

Analysis – August 2010

Cross-border financial activity in securities in August extended the trend of significant foreign investment in Canadian bonds and moderate Canadian investment in foreign equities that has been evident over most of the last 20 months. Non-residents purchased \$11.1 billion of Canadian securities in August with the majority of the investment going to corporate and government business enterprise bonds. Meanwhile, Canadians acquired \$3.4 billion of foreign securities, led by foreign stocks.

Non-residents favour Canadian corporate bonds

Non-residents invested \$10.8 billion in Canadian bonds in August, the second largest inflow in 2010. Canadian private corporate bonds attracted \$5.3 billion of foreign inflows, a level last seen in November 2009. Foreign acquisitions of net new issues accounted for nearly 60% of these inflows, led by bonds of resources and transportation firms offering attractive yields. In addition, non-residents continued to acquire sizeable amounts of Canadian mortgage bonds on secondary markets.

Foreign investors purchased \$3.2 billion worth of federal government enterprise bonds in August, the highest level since May 2009. Foreign inflows were almost equally split between net new issues and secondary market transactions.

Foreign purchases of both federal and provincial government bonds were lower in August. Over the month, Canadian long-term interest rates dropped to their lowest level since December 2008.

Note to readers

All values in this release are net transactions unless otherwise stated.

The data series on international security transactions cover portfolio transactions in stocks, bonds and money market instruments for both Canadian and foreign issues.

Stocks include common and preferred equities, as well as warrants.

Debt securities include bonds and money market instruments.

Bonds have an original term to maturity of more than one year.

Money market instruments have an original term to maturity of one year or less.

Government of Canada paper includes treasury bills and US-dollar Canada bills.

Non-residents reduced their holdings of Canadian money market instruments by \$705 million. The divestment was concentrated on paper issued by provinces and federal government enterprises, mainly due to retirements. Foreign investment in federal government paper slowed to \$404 million in August.

Foreign investment in Canadian stocks increases

Non-residents acquired \$995 million of Canadian stocks in August, driven by an increase in foreign purchases on secondary markets as Canadian stock prices rose 1.7%. This inflow was moderated by retirements of Canadian equities due to cross-border mergers and acquisitions.

Canadian investment in US stocks accelerates

Canadian investors added \$2.5 billion of foreign stocks to their portfolios in August, the largest such outflow since March. The activity was led again by pension and mutual funds. Of the investment, three-quarters were directed to US stocks, making for the 10th month of acquisitions of these instruments, even as American equity prices retreated 4.7% in August. The balance of the Canadian investment comprised acquisitions of non-US stocks, following a sizeable divestment in July.

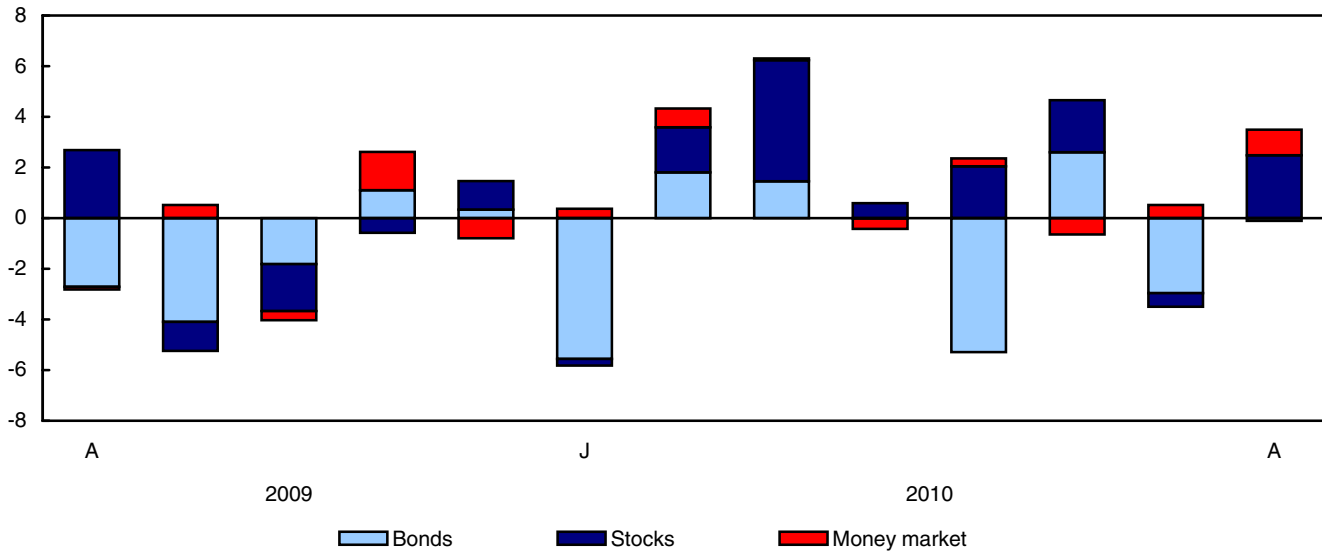
Canadians place funds in foreign short-term debt instruments

Canadians acquired \$1.0 billion of foreign money market instruments in August. This activity was the largest in nine months and focussed on US Treasury bills. The differential between long- and short-term US interest rates fell substantially in August as long-term rates dropped 50 basis points.

Residents further reduced their holdings of foreign bonds in August by \$109 million. The divestment was in US bonds, mostly US corporate bonds, due to retirements of maple bonds (the Canadian dollar-denominated foreign bonds). On the other hand, Canadians added bonds issued by European banks.
