7. The 95% confidence interval (CI) illustrates the degree of variability associated with a number or a rate. Wide confidence intervals indicate high variability, thus, these numbers or rates should be interpreted and compared with due caution.
8. Some age-standardized rates were suppressed (F) due to both a very small underlying count plus extremely high variability.
9. Unintentional ("accidental") injuries includes injuries due to causes such as motor vehicle collisions, falls, drowning, burns, and poisoning, but not medical misadventures/complications (ICD-9 E800-E929, excluding E870-E879).
10. "Health regions" are defined by the provincial ministries of health. These are legislated administrative areas in all provinces except Nova Scotia. In Nova Scotia, the Ministry of Health uses statistical "zones" rather than its legislated administrative areas; the zones are aggregations of the nine district health authorities.
11. For complete Canadian coverage, each of the northern territories also represents a health region.
