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Introduction

This publication presents data tables based on the 2008 General Social Survey on the subjects of civic and political engagement, sense of belonging, and unpaid work.

The General Social Survey (GSS) gathers data on social trends in order to monitor changes in Canadian society over time, and to provide information on specific social issues of current or emerging interest. The main purpose of the 2008 GSS was to better understand how Canadians mobilize their social networks to access resources at important periods of change in their lives. These changes include finances, employment, health, care of a sick person, death of a family member, etc. The survey collected information on topics such as changes experienced by respondents in the past 12 months, the resources they used during these events and unmet needs for help. Other topics included contact with family and friends, participation in organizations, voting, sense of belonging to Canada and unpaid care of children and seniors.

The General Social Survey previously collected data on social networks and social participation in 2003 (Cycle 17: Social Engagement).

Methods

The target population for the General Social Survey (GSS) was all persons 15 years of age and over residing in Canada, excluding:

- 1. Residents of the Yukon, Nunavut and Northwest Territories; and
- 2. Full-time residents of institutions.

In the survey, all respondents were contacted and interviewed by land-line (non-cellular) telephone. Households without land-line telephones were therefore excluded. However, persons living in such households represent less than 0.9% of the target population (Residential Telephone Service Survey (RTSS), December 2007). As interviews were not conducted by cellular telephone, persons with only cellular telephone service were also excluded. This group makes up 6.4% of the population (RTSS, December, 2007). Survey estimates have been adjusted (i.e. weighted) to account for persons without telephones.

Data for Cycle 22 of the GSS were collected from February to November 2008. The sample was distributed over the 10 months and was selected using the Elimination of Non-Working Banks technique of Random Digit Dialling (RDD).

The response rate was 57%. This was based on 20,401 respondents.

Data limitations

The figures which appear in this report are estimates based on data collected from a small fraction of the population (roughly one person in 1,300) and are subject to error. The error can be divided into two components: sampling error and non-sampling error.

Sampling error is the difference between an estimate derived from the sample and the one that would have been obtained from a census that used the same procedures to collect data from every person in the population. The size of the sampling error can be estimated from the survey results and an indication of the magnitude of this error is given for the estimates in this report. If the estimated sampling error is greater than 33% of the estimate, it is considered too unreliable to publish and the symbol 'F' is printed in table cells where this occurs. Although not considered too unreliable to publish, estimates with an estimated error between 16.6% and 33.3% of the related estimate should be "qualified" and used with caution. These are identified with an 'E'. Where there were insufficient data for particular provinces to allow for analysis, responses were aggregated into a regional table, such as the Atlantic or Prairie provinces.

All other types of errors, such as coverage, response, processing, and non-response, are non-sampling errors. Many of these errors are difficult to identify and quantify.

Coverage errors arise when there are differences between the target population and the surveyed population. Households without telephones represent a part of the target population that was excluded from the surveyed population. To the extent that this excluded population differs from the rest of the target population, the estimates will be biased. Since these exclusions are small, one would expect the biases introduced to be small. However, since there are correlations between a number of questions asked on this survey and the groups excluded, the biases may be more significant than the small size of the groups would suggest.

To the extent that the non-responding households and persons differ from the rest of the sample, the estimates will be biased. Non-response could occur at several stages in this survey. There were two stages of information collection: at the household level and at the individual level. As such, some non-response occurred at the household level, some at the individual level. Non-response also occurs at the level of individual questions.

For most questions, the response rate was high, with non-response indicated in the data files. While refusal to answer specific questions was very low, accuracy of recall and ability to answer some questions completely can be expected to affect some of the results presented.

Definitions

Hours spent doing unpaid housework, yard work or home maintenance for own household

This question was asked of all respondents.

Hours spent doing unpaid housework, yard work or home maintenance for persons outside the household

This question was asked of all respondents.

Hours spent looking after children in the household

This question was only asked of respondents with a child aged 14 years or less living in their household. Time spent when the respondent was doing another activity while looking after the children, time when looking after the children was shared with someone else and time when the child was having a nap were to be included in the hours spent.

Time the child spent sleeping during the night, at school, at a friend's or in organized activities was to be excluded.

Hours spent looking after children outside the household

This question was asked of all respondents; about looking after children who do not live in the respondent's household. Time spent when the respondent was doing another activity while looking after the children, time when looking after the children was shared with someone else and time when the child was having a nap were to be included in the hours spent.

Time the child spent sleeping during the night, at school, at a friend's or in organized activities was to be excluded.

Hours spent providing unpaid care or assistance to seniors in own household

This question was only asked of respondents who had a person (other than the respondent) 65 years of age or over living in their household.

Hours spent providing unpaid care or assistance to seniors outside the household

This question was asked of all respondents; about providing unpaid care or assistance to seniors who live outside the respondent's household.

Definitions (concluded)

Sense of belonging

Respondents were asked a series of questions about their sense of belonging, specifically:

How would you describe your sense of belonging to your local community? Would you say it is very strong, somewhat strong, somewhat weak or very weak?

What about your sense of belonging to your province?

What about your sense of belonging to Canada?

Respondents were not provided with a definition of "belonging", but rather, based their responses on their own understanding of the term.

Voting

The voting questions were asked of all respondents aged 18 years of age or over. The total counts and "did not vote" counts for these questions therefore also include those who were not eligible to vote. As the Cycle 22 data was collected during 2008, the terms "last federal election", "last provincial election" and "last municipal election" refer to the most recent elections held prior to collection.
