The information provided for each variable includes the associated question number(s), the response categories or classifications, and remarks about points of interest, such as the variable's history. The dictionary also contains a guide to census geography and applications, a general index and easy-to-read charts.

**1996 Census Dictionary – Final Edition** – Updates were made particularly to the appendices of the Census Dictionary and a few new definitions were added in this edition.

The 1996 Census Handbook – This publication presents a non-technical overview of the entire census process, from content determination to product and service delivery. It also deals with data quality and confidentiality and provides examples of various census data applications. In addition, it contains a brief history of census-taking in Canada.

1996 Census Technical Reports – These reports take a close look at the quality of the data produced by the vast, complex undertaking that was the 1996 Census. Despite the considerable effort taken to ensure high quality at every stage, the census results are likely to contain some degree of error. The reports focus on collection and processing operations and provide the results of data quality evaluation and notes on comparability with previous censuses.

The technical reports are intended for experienced users, but they are written so that any census data user may find them helpful.

## Geographic reference products

**1997 Geography Catalogue** – The 1997 Geography Catalogue provides information about the geographic products and services produced by Statistics Canada. It contains short descriptions of the products and services, including information on price, medium and catalogue numbers.

GeoSuite (formerly GeoRef) – This is a powerful data retrieval and tabular output tool with software and data on a CD-ROM. Users can explore the links between standard geographic levels and determine geographic codes, names, and population and dwelling counts. GeoSuite also provides EA correspondence data (for 1996 Census EAs and 1991 Census EAs) and an EA reference map listing that facilitates identification of appropriate EA reference maps.

Reference maps – These maps show the geography of the census and help users find the boundaries of census regions so that they can relate census data to physical locations. Over 7,500 reference maps are produced, covering various geographic levels, including enumeration areas (the unit used for census collection), federal electoral districts (ridings) according to the 1987 Representation Order, census tracts (neighbourhoods), census agglomerations and census metropolitan areas (large urban centres), census subdivisions (municipalities) and census divisions (counties and "municipalités régionales de comté"). Reference maps are sold individually or in sets.

Most reference products are available in hard-copy form. Technical reports are available on the Internet as well as in hard-copy form and the final editions of the 1996 Census Catalogue and 1996 Census Dictionary are available on Internet only. GeoSuite is published on CD-ROM.

## Large Urban Enumeration Area (EA) Reference Maps

These black and white EA reference maps cover all 25 census metropolitan areas (CMAs) and the 18 census agglomerations (CAs) that are in the census tract program. Approximately 4,200 maps - generally one map per census tract - show enumeration area (EA) boundaries and codes on a background of detailed street networks and other visible features. Also shown on the maps are census tract, census subdivision, federal electoral district and CMA or CA boundaries. These maps are reproduced on demand. A reference guide is included.

The maps are completely redesigned for 1996. Each map fits on a 11" x 17" page size (approximately 27 cm x 43 cm). Map scales vary according to the size of the census tract; thus the maps cannot be cut and pasted together. In cases where the map is too congested to fit on one page, the map may be split into two or four parts. Clients are not charged for the extra split maps. All maps are computer-generated. Most were produced from Street Network File (SNF) information, but approximately 10% of the maps were generated from Natural Resources Canada's National Topographic Data Base (NTDB) files. The appearance and quality of the maps from the NTDB source are somewhat different from those from the SNF.

## Census Division and Census Subdivision (CD/CSD) Reference Maps - Individual Maps

A total of 21 provincial maps showing the boundaries, names and codes for census divisions (areas such as counties and regional districts) and census subdivisions (such as cities, municipalities, towns, villages, other local municipal entities, townships and Indian reserves) are available for sale individually.
